**General Meeting – Sept. 19, 2007**

Mission Valley Resort

Called to Order: 7:10 p.m.

75 members signed in and at least 14 guests were in attendance.

**Pledge of Allegiance**

**Secretary's Report - Paul Grimes**

Skimmer Minutes were approved.

Paul stressed how important it is to update your phone numbers and addresses.

**Treasurer's Report – Jim Bauer**

We're in good shape financially.

**President's Report – Mike Gregg**

Mike advised that the BORD is considering alternatives to the shrinking Benevolent Fund, which may be unable to continue providing minimum benefits.

The BORD is considering the below options:

1. Bumping our life insurance from \$30,000 to \$50,000 for a net dues increase of \$3.25 per month.
2. \$100,000 vs. \$50,000 benefit for accidental death at a total net dues increase of \$5.10/month.

The membership in attendance discussed the issue and voted on the below alternatives (votes):

- Drop the Benevolent Fund (30)
- Take the \$50,000 policy (12)
- Take the \$50k plus \$100k accidental death benefit (6)
- Take the \$1/month Benevolent Fund fee and buy additional life insurance. (6)

In summation, 18 members (33%) voted for the new insurance plans while 36 (67%) voted for either no added insurance or utilizing the \$1 for some additional life insurance. Regional Director Javier Payan will be advised of our vote.

Members will be mailed a ballot to vote on whether BORD members should have the current term limits removed.

At the October meeting, we will be again taking photos of members and Chapter Supporters. Mark Curran specifically requested that Chapter Supporters come a little early to have their photos taken.
