RAINY DAYS AND DROWNING PREVENTION

With all of the rain that we have had during the past several weeks, it is easy to get caught up in trying to get out pools back into shape and lose sight of the fact that large amounts of rainfall produce additional hazards around the pool and our customers' properties. Mary Ann Downing, the Pool Safety Mom shares the following points for us to consider in keeping our pools safe:

- Overflowing swimming pools may be a curiosity for little kids who venture out after it stops raining

Make sure all pools have a hose bib installed for draining excess water from the pool and that your customer knows how to operate it.

- Pool safety covers need to be drained of standing water.

- The water level in pools with safety nets needs to be low enough that the net is several inches above the water to prevent submersion

- High winds and heavy rains may have brought down parts of wooden fences that could allow access to the pool by neighboring kids. Also, water logged gates may not be closing or latching properly.

Take the time to inspect for these issues and advise the homeowner of any problems.

Remember, our customers depend on us to ensure that their pool and the surrounding area is safe.

Drowning prevention isn't just an opportunity, it is a responsibility. Thanks for doing your part to prevent drowning.



Region 7 Director's Notes

This will be an unusual report due to my stupidity on the evening of our quarterly region meeting. It is held at an SCP facility in Mira Mesa, a part of the county I am not familiar with. There are several buildings that look alike and although I had been there previously, it was always daylight savings time. The night of the meeting, myself and Dave Talbot (Carlsbad president), joined by John Hackett and Matt Hughes (Escondido president & president elect) waited outside the wrong building for 45 minutes freezing our bippies off before calling it quits, all the time wondering where everyone was and why no one was there to open the building. Got home and there was a message on my answering machine wondering where I was. Oops, wrong building!

There were several past presidents and two past Region 7 directors in attendance, and although I had the agendas, they carried on a reasonable meeting. The minutes that follow are a reasonable record of what occurred. Subsequent to the meeting I noted from the minutes that there was a request for more money than was available from the IPSSA matching funds account. A conference call meeting was scheduled by phone and e-mail for 5:00 p.m. on December 26 to address this issue. This meeting was called on short notice so the matching funds request could be approved and a check cut and distributed in 2009. This became a moot point when the request was denied.

The meeting was called to order at 5:05 p.m., and a quorum was present: Dave Talbot, Carlsbad; Brian Lindlar, N. County Coastal; Lance Clifton, Rancho Del Mar; and Mark Curran & Bill Peck, San Diego. Motion made by Lindlar, seconded by Peck and carried to reduce the request for IPSSA matching funds to that available, \$1,752.73. Motion by Lindlar, seconded by Peck and carried to authorize Gough to make a judgment call on the appropriate action to be taken on the CDs when the bank accounts are switched from Bank of America to Union Bank, this switch being necessary to avoid Bank of America's \$60 per month service charge. Meeting adjourned 5:25 p.m.

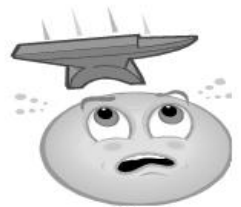

Legislature Considering 3% Withholding of Fees Paid to Independent Contractors

Tuesday, February 9, 2010

California legislators are reportedly considering adding language to a state budget bill that would mandate a 3% withholding of fees paid to independent contractors, possibly including fees paid to pool service professionals.

This proposal could be included in a budget bill to be sent to Governor Schwarzenegger within the next week or so as part of the 8th Special Legislative Session currently underway to address California's budget deficit.

"Such a proposal only robs working capital from law abiding independent contractors and forces people into the underground economy," said John Norwood, SPEC President. "The pool and spa industry, and the service industry in particular, is in a perfect position to mount a campaign to oppose this proposal. Service professionals live and work in every legislative district in California."

SPEC is requesting that every member of the spa and pool industry, pool service technicians in particular, immediately contact their state Senator or Assembly Member to voice opposition to this ill-conceived proposal.

Attached is a sample letter SPEC has prepared for industry professionals that can be personalized and used to fax or e-mail **immediately** to their legislators in opposition to this proposal. DON'T WAIT – send it now! SPEC members can determine the Senator and Assembly Member(s) representing their district by visiting <http://www.leginfo.ca.gov/yourleg.html>, and entering the zip code of your place of business or residence. From there, you will be presented with the link to each legislator's website, where you can either cut and paste the personalized sample letter and e-mail, or obtain the fax or mailing address.

The California Chamber of Commerce, along with some 100 associations and organizations, is implementing an all out campaign to oppose this flawed idea and the pool and spa industry must have their voice heard as well.

"This is an extremely important issue that SPEC members need to take seriously. A budget fix bill must be sent to the Governor within the next couple of weeks. If we jump on this issue now we can likely stop such a proposal from being considered this year," Norwood concluded.

SAMPLE LETTER OPPOSING INDEPENDENT CONTRACTOR WITHHOLDING PROPOSAL

[DATE]

Dear Assembly Member / Senator _____:

I am a small business owner in your district. My company, _____, employs _____ persons. We have been in business in _____ since _____.

I am writing to oppose the independent contractor withholding proposal. This is another budget gimmick that does not generate more revenue to the State of California. Instead, it merely accelerates monies that will already be paid to the State and imposes an onerous burden upon small businesses like my company.

Under this proposal, businesses in this state would be required to collect taxes from other businesses and we would serve as a collection agent for the State. The new expense of withholding and remitting these monies to the Franchise Tax Board would be a cost borne by small businesses, effectively providing interest-free loans to the state. Even if we, as independent contractor, owes no state taxes, 3% would still be withheld, affecting our cash flow and impacting our business.

In an already difficult time for many businesses, including the hard hit swimming pool and spa industry of which I am a member, this proposal adds one more burden that could push us over the edge.

I believe this proposal is unreasonable and should be rejected by the Legislature. I would appreciate hearing from you at your earliest convenience as to your position on this ill-conceived proposal.
