Dept. of Public Health Cedes Role in CA-VGB Law

A so-called trailer bill to the California state budget has ceded the authority of the Department of Public Health to the federal government for approval of changes to the California VGB law and left enforcement to local public health officials. In an apparent move to save dollars, AB 1467 was enacted as part of the state budget and supported by the Brown administration. The bill makes a number of amendments to the California Health & Safety Codes that were enacted in 2009 to add provisions that would bring California in compliance with the federal VGB Act.

Among the changes enacted by AB 1467 is a new paragraph added to H&S Code Section 116064.2 (k) which provides that the Department shall have no authority to take any enforcement action against any person for violation of this section and has no responsibility to administer or enforce the provisions of this section. In addition, sections of the current law which authorized the Department to charge a fee to owners of public pools to be collected by local health departments have been stricken from the law. The enactment of H&S Code Section 116064.2 goes back to AB 1020 in 2009 designed to implement the federal VGB law in California. Pursuant to that legislation the California Department of Public Health was to develop and distribute a form to be used by all the counties to implement the VGB law. The intent of using a statewide form was to establish consistency among the counties so public pool owners and swimming pool professionals would not have to deal with 58 different county standards. AB 1020 authorized the Department of Public Health to

change a fee for the development and distribution of the form, said fee to be collected by the local health departments. The new bill, AB 1467 eliminates the fee and the authority of the Department to implement the act. In addition, current law requires every public pool to be equipped with antientrapment devices or systems that comply with ASME/ANSI performance standard A112.19.8, as in effect on December 31, 2009 or any applicable ASME/ANSI or ANSI/APSP performance standard adopted by the Department. AB 1467 removes the authority of the Department of Public Health to approve any standard or new devices. The new language requires state antientrapment devices to comply with ANSI/APSP-16-2011 as in effect on December 13th, 2011.

Current law also provides that any public pool with a single main drain that is not an unblockable main drain to be equipped with at least one or more of four backup devices to prevent suction entrapment. For each of the four specified devices the statute calls for compliance with a particular ASME/ANSI performance standard and allows alternative devices adopted by the Department of Public Health. AB 1476 removes the authority for the Department to adopt alternative standards for antientrapment devices.

"The changes to the California VGB bill were contained in a 169 page bill that made numerous changes to unrelated sections of the Health & Safety Code. All of this done essentially behind closed doors as part of the budget process," stated John Norwood, President of SPEC. "There were over 30 budget trailer bills this year that are almost impossible to keep track of as they do not have to comply with the procedures of the regular legislative session and are often not even in print when they are heard in committee." Now that budget bills can be enacted by a majority rather than 2/3 votes of both houses, there is virtually no safeguards to the legislative process," continued Norwood.

SPEC is the sponsor of AB 2114 which, among other things is amending some of the same sections of the H&S Code dealing with public pools. The association is taking a close look at the changes made in AB 1467 to see if other modifications are warranted. Among these issues is whether the performance standards for antientrapment devices are in need of being updated and whether we can add language which will automatically update the code when performance standards are updated by ANSI/APSP. AB 2114 is currently in the Senate Appropriations Committee to be heard in early August.
