Pool Surface Forensics 101

In Pool Surface Forensics 101, the students will learn how to properly evaluate an interior finish. Each student will be provided with an equipment list ranging from the most basic to the advanced items needed to properly investigate a pool with concerns. Each student will also be given an outline of the items to check and question such that cause/effect relationships can be defined by looking at the "Big 5".. Material, Workmanship, Environmental, Water Chemistry or a Combination of these issues.

Pool Surface Forensics 201

In Pool Surface Forensics 201, the student will take one of the "Big 5", Water Chemistry- and learn the essentials of testing source water and pool water with the outlook of developing and understanding how sanitizers, types of acid, and cyanuric acid can create changes in our pool surfaces. Two technical bulletins from Taylor Technologies will be handed out along with a course outline.

CPSA Drought Campaign Now Online

The severe drought conditions threatening water supplies across the state has prompted the California Pool and Spa Association to become a part of the solution before overzealous lawmakers react without being thoroughly informed of the pool and spa industry's minimal use of water. Similar to previous droughts, the CPSA has implemented a public outreach drought awareness campaign, titled "Let's Pool Together," to educate water districts and the public regarding responsible water use.

The CPSA launched the Let's Pool Together website on Monday of this week, which serves as a platform for pool and spa professionals to direct their consumers and members of the public to a source highlighting how little water swimming pools use as well as practices that will save even more water. The website also includes a water savings calculator that allows users to input the size of the prospective or current swimming pool and decking area to determine specifically how much water the pool would save in comparison to a grass landscape. Furthermore, the website will incorporate a hidden page only accessible to CPSA members, which will include materials tailored for builders, distributors and service companies to disseminate to their customers, such as bill stuffers, retail posters, and water-use fact sheets. The campaign website also utilizes the popularity of social media networks by integrating a Facebook and Twitter account designed to reach a larger audience, attract attention, and garner support. These materials will collectively demonstrate to the public that while being a pool and spa owner inherently makes them a part of the drought solution, there are even more ways to conserve water.

CPSA is also in the process of establishing a partnership with the Association of California Water Agencies (ACWA) to aide in spreading awareness regarding how pools save water, the industry's efforts to help save even more water, and the millions of dollars generated to state and local economies through this small business dominated industry. Since California has more than 700 water districts, all with the legal jurisdiction to impose restrictions on water use, a partnership with ACWA is key to amplify the voice of the industry.
