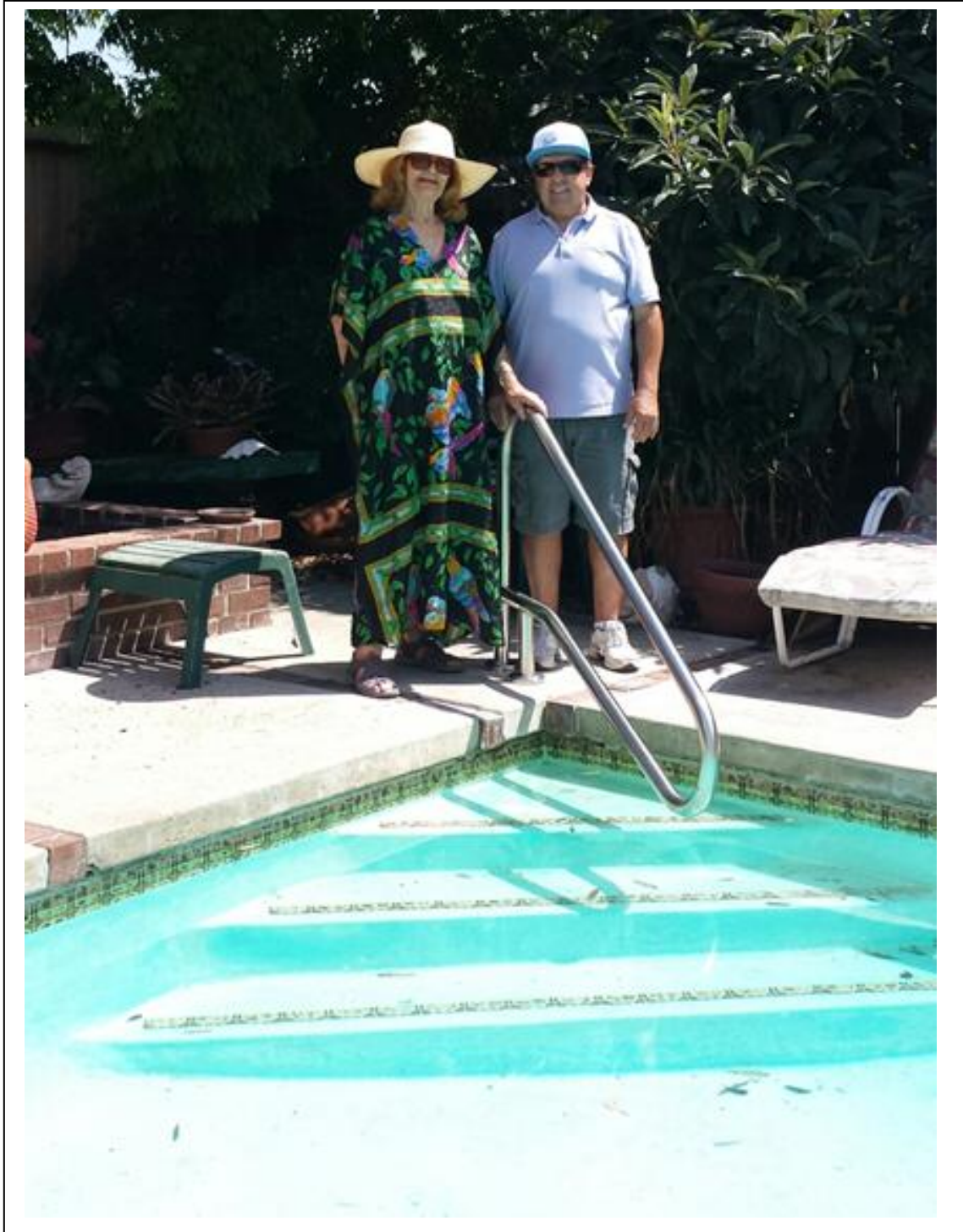

She indicated that she was anxious to get back into the water.

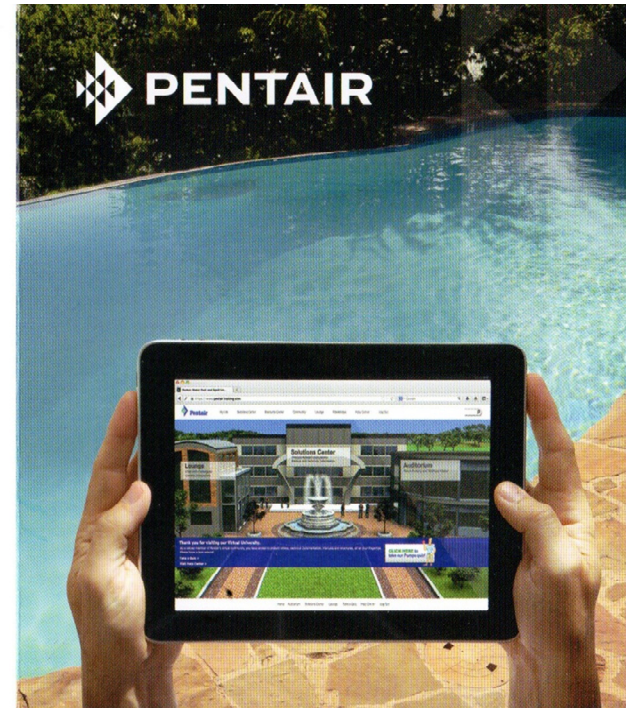

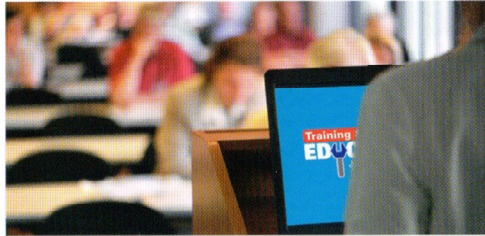
