Most recently and as a result of Winter Storm Uri and Viola, over 75% of chlorine, caustic soda, hydrochloric acid, and HDPE (High Density Polyethylene), manufacturing capacity in the United States was either shutdown entirely or severely disabled. All major producers and distributors of chlorine, caustic soda, hydrochloric acid, and HDPE have declared force majeure and consequently, have announced and are implementing extreme and substantial price increases.

The announced price increase totals as a percent of the Independent Commodity Intelligence Services (I-C-I-S) base price indexes for February 2020 indicate:

- Chlorine +110%
- Hydrochloric acid +125%
- Caustic soda +26%

In addition, Blow Molding HDPE resins are 136% higher in February 2021 vs. February 2020.

In response to these dramatic inflationary pressures, Hasa is increasing prices for all packaged sodium hypochlorite, muriatic acid, and ancillary products by 15% effective April 5, 2021. For minibulk customers, Hasa is increasing prices by 10%, or as contract terms permit, and your Hasa sales representative will contact you to discuss specifics regarding this minibulk increase. This applies to shipments from all Hasa locations in Arizona, California, Nevada, Texas, and Washing. This increase is necessary to partially offset the above mentioned higher raw material costs as well as increased labor, production, transportation, and insurance costs.
