President's Message

Hello Members and Supporters,

I hope all is going well for you, both in your business life and your personal life. It certainly has been a challenging time within the industry. We are experiencing situations never before seen in the pool and spa world. The demand for service, repair, remodeling, and new construction is greater than it has ever been as the general public focuses their attention on home life. The backyards and swimming pools have become top priority as people reorganize their lives with the emphasis on family, working from home, traveling less, home schooling, and using their homes for entertaining as they feel safer there than out in public as the Covid virus continues to spread. Hopefully you've adjusted your service rates to keep up with the cost of doing business. With the press coverage of chemical shortages and price increases, I'm sure your

customers are aware and expect a rate increase.

This Wednesday's General Meeting will be at the usual location, Admiral Baker Country Club, at the usual time, 7:00 PM. Prior to the meeting, representatives from Ultimate Water will conduct a one hour seminar beginning at 6:00 PM to introduce their product called the Chlorine Genie. It is a unit that is installed at the pool equipment site, is self contained, and manufactures chlorine using salt within the unit to chlorinate the pool while also maintaining Ph, thus avoiding purchasing chlorine or acid. Considering how expensive both have gotten over the past year (when available) this sounds like the right product at the right time. They will have at least one unit on hand to show how their system works, how to maintain it, service it, and repair it. Please arrive early as the seminar will begin at 6:00 PM. This will be worth one Continuing Education Point for Chapter Members.

We had a terrific turnout for last month's two hour seminar performed by David Hawes prior to the meeting and I hope to see a similar or better response this week. Food will be provided by the Chapter to all who attend.
